## Mrs. sims' kindergarten sight words

To become successful readers, children must have knowledge of words that occur with frequency when reading. These high frequency or "sight" words are the most commonly occurring words that beginning readers see in text. Some of these words do not follow basic phonics rules and are considered "irregular". This year, I will be teaching your child how to map these words in their brain. This is called orthographic mapping, i.e. storing words into long term memory so that they are recognized instantly, without decoding (sounding out). In a nutshell....your child will learn most of the 44 letter sounds (phonemes) in the English language. I will teach these in conjunction with our phonics program, Fundations.

We will have a list with 4-5 new words each week. Please remember to practice sight words with your child daily. Your child will be assessed on his/her ability to read these words. This list is for your reference. Please practice ONLY the words we have learned to date, so that I can properly teach how to remember the words before they come home. Your support at home will enable your child to become an amazing reader!
